All credit templates and supporting documentation are saved on the internet through LEED-Online. Credit templates can be saved at any point, even if they are only partially complete.

The resistance of a material to penetration by a liquid is referred to as _____.



Imperviousness. The total imperviousness of a surface, such as paving, is expressed as a percentage of the total surface area that does not allow moisture penetration. Impervious surfaces prevent rainwater from infiltrating into the ground, which increases runoff, reduces groundwater recharge, & degrades water quality.

What is the benchmark of performance for a fixture to be considered “low flow”?



Low flow fixtures are defined as using at least 30% less water over a conventional fixture.

Daylight Factor
vs.
Daylight Glazing



The daylight factor is the ratio of exterior illumination to interior illumination, expressed as a percentage. Daylight glazing is a vertical window area located 7'-6" or higher above the floor."

What material is assumed to have a minimum post-consumer recycled content when no supporting documentation can be obtained?



Steel - always assume 25% post-consumer recycled content if no other information is available.
